Please provide the following supplies:

1. A sturdy table, about the size of a card table, covered with a white tablecloth.
 2. An additional small table (not needed if the main table is larger than a card table).
 3. A small wastebasket with a plastic bag liner.
 4. 50- 3x3 individually wrapped gauze pads (most are for aftercare).
 5. A large container of Vaseline (tube or tub).
 6. A disposable diaper and diaper wipes (or soft cloths and warm water if you prefer).
 7. 3- cloth diapers (“burp cloths”).
 8. A standard bed pillow with a white pillow case.
 9. A kiddush cup
 10. A challah

- I bring candlesticks and candles for those who wish to do a candle lighting, but you may use your own set if you wish.
 - I bring a bottle of grape juice with me, but you may use your own kosher wine or juice if you wish. The wine should be sweet, not dry.
